ALEXANDER DEVINE CHILDREN'S HOSPICE

Alexander Devine Children's Hospice Service was set up by Fiona and John Devine in memory of their courageous son, Alexander, who was diagnosed with a rare brain tumour at just four years of age.

For another four years he bravely fought against the cancer, but sadly died aged just eight. However, in his short life, he touched many people's lives within the community, and remains the inspiration behind the charity to this day.

Fiona and John's experience of caring for Alexander led them to realise there was a pressing need for a children's hospice service in...

Berkshire, backed up by a community outreach team. Research has shown that there are currently 260 children living with life-limiting conditions throughout Berkshire who could benefit from this service. That's 260 families who are having to travel significant distances if they need a children's hospice service - this can have a tremendous impact on a family who may not only be caring for a sick child, but also looking after other family members. In October 2009 the charity was able to fund its first "Alexander Nurse" - A community paediatric palliative care specialist nurse who is now providing dedicated care and support for local children with life-limiting conditions and their families in their own homes. The great news is that the charity hopes to recruit a second nurse who will be in post by the Spring of this year, and who will be based at the Royal Berkshire Hospital, Reading, supporting families in West Berkshire.
