4. St. Edward's 150 Anniversary

Meeting planned for the end of May. Proposed diary events:

- d) Civic Mass June. Various local dignitaries to be invited.

- Project to support our twin diocese of Bamenda. Aim: developing an evangelisation activity with an element of legacy.

SP met with the Chair of the group in Portsmouth. Conversations are continuing. Possible options being explored:

Faith, health, education, social welfare (e.g.: the building of a well).

Another consideration could be the focusing on a particular activity or resource which would support an aspect of faith within the community. What is known about current needs or those into the 'future;' for example, the need for a vehicle to help people get around the diocese.

5. PPC – The Way Forward

Bishop Philip has suggested that in response to the need for evangelisation, each Pastoral Area should establish an Evangelisation Strategy Team (EST).

The ESTs will be 'a new body to replace the Pastoral Council...Its purpose is to sponsor mission-projects across the area.'

Considerations:

- Change of focus for the PPC. Evolving, refreshing and building upon the work done to date.
- How are we reaching out into the community?
- Recognition that we need to be involved with what is going on within the wider community, e.g. parish representation in events such as the 'Walk of Witness.'
- Could the Sion community return to advise on this?
- Father Liam may be able to offer guidance on this during the PPC Retreat to Douai in July.
