

## 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

10<sup>th</sup> July 2022

In the parable of the Good Samaritan, there are several characters of importance. A traveller attacked by brigands and left for dead. A priest and a Levite who came along but ignored the wounded man. Then the Samaritan (despised by the Jews) who offered assistance, his money and most importantly, his time to restore this injured man to good health. In his encyclical, Fratelli Tutti, Pope Francis asks a direct but difficult question, 'Which of these persons do you identify with?' 'Which of these characters do you resemble?'

Through this parable, Jesus instructs us on the law of charity. It encompasses going beyond the fundamentals in our Christian living. Moses exhorts the Israelites that that they need not overcome obstacles to retrieve this law. It is already written in our hearts manifested by the gentle promptings of the Spirit. The Law of Charity which Christ enjoins on us is simply 'Love of God and Love of neighbour.' The question lies are we willing to live it out?

The story of the good Samaritan evokes not just compassion but action. How often have we been quick to judge the homeless beggar on the streets and walked on? Or lost patience with our child who needed attention so we could indulge ourselves? Or ignored an invitation to volunteer with a Parish society or a Charity? If I cannot help financially, can I offer my time?

Thankfully, we have various groups in our Parish and our locality with a charisma driven by this Divine law of Charity such as the SVP, Mini Vinies, Hospitality team, HCTP, Youth Group, Windsor Foodshare and many more. If you are not a member already, would you consider joining one? Would you consider donating your time or money in response to the Lord's invitation today?
