### Thought for the Week

In the Gospel this weekend, we hear about the Spirit of Truth. The truth into which the Holy Spirit guides us, is the truth about Christ. The Spirit also helps us through patient practice to discern right from wrong.

Jesus told the disciples that the Holy Spirit would tell them 'what is to come' - the nature of their mission, the opposition they would face and the final outcome of their efforts. They didn't fully understand these promises until the Holy Spirit came after Jesus' death and resurrection. Then the Holy Spirit reveals truth to the disciples that they wrote down in the books that now form the New Testament. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God himself.

The Trinity is who God really is: a real, personal, wise and loving God.
