# **Thought for the Week**

In a way John the Baptist is Advent, just as, in another way, Mary is. Both, in complementary ways, prepared for the coming of Christ. Mary,



as his mother, made his birth possible, his becoming one of us; she gave the Word flesh. John as his herald, would baptise him 30 years later. This was the beginning of the public life of Jesus. Mary stands for faith and obedience.' I am the handmaid of the Lord; let what you have said be done to me'. John stands for repentance. 'repent for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand' - in other words change your attitudes or change how you live. With Mary, Advent begins in a village, in a home in the middle of daily life, where an Angel finds her. With John it begins in the desert, away from the world. 'The word of God came to John, son of Zechariah, in the wilderness'.

Jesus never comes alone. He comes with the Father and the Holy Spirit. He comes with all the figures of the Old Testament behind him. He comes surrounded by people: Zechariah and Elizabeth, Mary and Joseph, the shepherds and the wise men, Simeon and Anna, and John the Baptist, later all the disciples. The coming of Christ to us is the same, 'your friends are my friends'. We are never alone, for we are part of the Church , both in this world and the world to come.

Being part of this family of God comes with responsibility. When we sin and offend God and others, we let down Christ and all his friends. The call of his friend John the Baptist rings true today as he speaks to us to REPENT. Advent is a season of hope because we can repent and not only have our sins forgiven, but be filled with the Holy Spirit, as was Mary. Reconciliation brings forgiveness and the grace to live better lives.

I invite you to go to Confession during this season of hope. The Reconciliation Service will take place on Saturday, 10 December at 10:00. There will be many priests available to help us celebrate this Sacrament. If you have not been to Confession for years - then this could be your time.
