

# Second Sunday in Ordinary Time −15 January 2023

#### Thought for the Week

At Mass, just after we pray the 'Our Father', the celebrant prays that the Lord will grant the Church 'peace and unity in accordance with your will.'

The words 'peace and unity' often seem at odds with each other and in our world today both appear difficult if not impossible to achieve. This Sunday is a Day of Prayer for Peace and on Thursday, Christian denominations around the world begin the Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity to help achieve Christ's prayer at the Last Supper 'that they all be one'; in the same week, peace in the world and unity in the church are the specific focus of prayer.

A year ago, we were concerned about the possibility of fighting in Ukraine and 12 months later, we are all grieving for the loss of life, and the heartache and destruction which the conflict has seen. Both church unity and conflicts, in Ukraine, Syria, Yemen and other trouble spots of the world, may seem too much for us to resolve. We may not feel that we can change the world and bring about peace and unity, but we can each contribute to peace and unity in our homes, our parish family, and our community. Perhaps this week we can focus on achieving our own small step towards peace and unity; as Mother Theresa said, 'If you want to change the world, go home and love your family'. In addition, we must also remember that we can pray; it is, after all, our faith that prayer can change the world!
