

# Sixth Sunday of Easter 7 May 2023

### Thought for the Week

It was the night before Jesus' death. For some time he had been giving the Apostles hints of his death, now he talked openly about it; however he did not speak of death in the way we tend to, in the sense of life ending. He spoke of his death as going away, going to the Father; but all the Apostles heard was the fact that he was leaving them.

The thing that would have been a great consolation to the Apostles at this sad hour, even as he spoke about leaving them, was that he spoke about coming back to them. He would come to them through the Spirit, and when they encountered him after the resurrection. Even though after the Ascension they would see him no more, he assured them that he would still be with them, even to the end of time.

Jesus did not leave his disciples orphaned or desolate. By their faith they were able to see him, and through their obedience to his commandments, they were drawn into a loving communion with him.

In the same way he does not leave us orphaned, we have the same access to his presence and to the help of the Holy Spirit as did the very first Christians.

No where do we feel so close to him as when we receive him in the Eucharist. When we receive the Eucharist we are not just in communion with Him, but He is in communion with us, a holy communion, where he nourishes our hearts with his love. The food of the Eucharist gives each one of us the strength to do his word and to live as his disciples.
