

# Seventh Sunday of Easter 21 May 2023

## Thought for the Week

This Sunday's reading from the Acts of the Apostles paints a very vivid picture; of the eleven disciples, Jesus's mother and others, all gathered in an upper room praying. It echoes, yet strongly contrasts with, the actions of the disciples just after the Resurrection only some 40 days earlier. Then, they locked themselves away in fear, now there feels to be a confidence and strength among the group; there is no mention of bolted doors, there is no mention of running for cover or hiding; they appear to calmly walk a sabbath walk into the city from the Mount of Olives, stay together and pray.

Yet they have just seen the risen Jesus make his farewells and ascend to the Father, this could lower their moods, but on the contrary, faith and trust, as a consequence of all they have seen and experienced over the past six weeks has given them strength and indeed optimism. After all, they have been promised that the Holy Spirit will come down on them: there is something to wait for, and pray for, and about which to feel expectant.

The assembly of the closest followers of Jesus are gathered around his mother, someone who, from her experiences in Nazareth some thirty years before, knew the impact and power of the Holy Spirit; she knew how the Spirit can turn the world upside down. As we wait alongside the disciples and Mary for Pentecost and the Spirit, we too have an opportunity to gather and pray. If we open ourselves and prepare to welcome the Holy Spirit into our lives, perhaps our worlds may be turned upside down too.
