### Thought for the Week

### The Body and Blood of Christ

St Paul in the second reading uses a loaf of bread as a symbol of our unity in Christ. Once we were separated from one another but now we have been gathered together to form the Body of Christ: the Church. As one body, we become living witnesses of God's desire to bring all peoples and nations together into one family. During the week, our parish community is scattered over this area and further afield. But here at Mass we are brought together, here we are the Body of Christ made visible.

Here we lay down our differences and become one family. Here we can come 'in from the cold' and experience the warmth of the community. Love is the atmosphere we breathe here. We must try to rise above the things that prevent us from experiencing and expressing our unity – shyness, coldness and indifference.

The Eucharist is the sign and source of our unity. We form a single body because we all share in the one loaf. We can't be truly 'in communion' with Jesus without being 'in communion' with each other.

Alas, when we leave the church at the end of Mass, we tend to forget all this. We no longer recognise the ties that exist between us and go our own ways. When we depart from here we must take out into the world some of the warmth and love we have experienced here.

The team are now accepting registrations for the 2023-24 First Holy Communion programme. Further details plus application forms can be found on the Parish website. Kindly send completed application forms and a copy of your child's baptismal certificate to <u>fhc@catholicwindsor.org</u>. A meeting for parents will be held on 21 September 18:30.

For those families wishing to enrol their children (who are in year 3 or above) we shall be having a threefold programme, as follows: **Step 1**: 'Come and See' (John1: 39-41)

For 6 weekends from the 23/24 September to the end of October. The candidate is required to attend weekend Masses with family members. At the beginning of November, a

The Holy Communion Mass will be followed by an invitation to do something for the community and will be introduced to the Mini Vinnies in the parish (Junior SVP).

At this meeting of parents, you will receive the 'Record Card' that needs to be stamped when you attend Mass. Further dates will be given at this meeting.

# New Pastoral Area

We are delighted to announce that the inaugural gathering of the newly formed Pastoral Area of St Edward's and St Francis recently took place in Ascot. Representatives from both parishes, a total of 10 individuals, joined together to establish a shared vision grounded on the significance of liturgy and evangelisation. Several key themes emerged from the meeting, including the importance of maintaining our collective and individual identities, encouraging us to visit our churches, and explore how we can grow as a vibrant and inclusive Catholic community.

From next week we will be asking for your thoughts on the name for our new Pastoral Area so we can define our collective identity. There will be a special week of celebration from 4 to 13 October, during which we will commemorate various feast days that hold great significance for our Pastoral Area.
