

# <u>Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary time - 16 July 2023</u> <u>Thought for the Week</u>

Jesus's audience would have recognised the pastoral imagery of the Sower and the seed in his parable even if they did not immediately grasp its meaning. This week's readings are full of powerful agricultural images – of the farmer and the grain which he scatters and the rain that waters it. Variously, the seed falls onto the edge of paths, on patches of rock, among thorns or rich soil. Some yield a great harvest, while others are swiftly eaten up, or germinate rapidly but wither quickly, and others are choked by weeds. In the psalm we hear how the rains from heaven drench the furrows of the fields and the Almighty lovingly, even tenderly, levels the ground, and softens it with showers to yield a rich harvest. The psalmist speaks of meadows covered with flocks and valleys decked with wheat 'shouting for joy', while the prophet Isaiah tells how God's word – like the rain which waters the earth to help produce rich harvests – does not return to him empty.

Jesus speaks of us as the seed and explains that, depending on how we hear 'the word of the kingdom', each one of us is able to yield a great harvest of faith, for ourselves and each other; alternatively, depending on circumstances, that faith can wither, be choked or be overwhelmed. It is sometimes easy to read this as a one-time event, the farmer scattering the seed just once and that we only have a single chance; but perhaps we forget that the Sower spread seed twice in a year, for harvests of barley and wheat, the rains softened the earth before sowing and watered the crops through winter and spring. Think of how many harvests we will see in our lives, how many times the seed will be scattered when we will hear the word, and how many chances we still have to yield a rich harvest.
