As part of the gradual unification of the parishes of Ascot and Windsor, Fr Kevin and I did a swap of altars and communities last week. We all get used to familiar people, celebrants and liturgies - so a change can be a good thing, for the priests and the people! Both our parishes have different strengths and traditions, I believe that by unifying this, we will be a stronger Catholic presence in this part of the diocese. St Paul in his letter at Mass this weekend says: 'there must be no competition among you, no conceit; everybody is to be selfeffacing. Always consider the other person to be better than yourself, so that nobody thinks of his own interests first, but everybody thinks of other people's interest instead.' I think these words that we hear this weekend are worth pondering and praying over.

This coming Wednesday, we will celebrate the Feast of Saint Francis - patron of the Catholic community in Ascot. St Francis has a Mass at 19:30 on Wednesday 4th October, I intend to go, and I hope that many of you will be able to join me in supporting them.
