

# 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time - 19 November 2023 Thought for the Week

What is a talent? We hear about them in this week's Gospel reading of the parable of the three servants who were given responsibility for their master's wealth while he travelled. Two double their money but one, fearful of his master, buries it and returns it untouched. The first two are praised; the third severely rebuked. A talent was a huge sum in Roman times, some 36 kilos in weight and when measured in silver, each would be worth about £60,000 today. If the text is only seen in monetary terms the master who made a healthy profit from his two entrepreneurial staff could understandably be disappointed by the one who hadn't tried at all.

It is very easy to focus on the financial interpretation of Jesus's words but what about another way of looking at talents - thinking of them as skills and abilities? Each one of us has talents given to us by God; do we use them to the best advantage, do we build on what we have and, by using them make profit for our family, friends, neighbours, our community; are we disappointing the Lord by not doing so? It's always worth asking ourselves which of the servants am I — one who used and shared the talents they had received to wider benefit or the one hiding away their talents, burying them?

Rather than money or skills, what about considering the talents as a gift of love, mercy and forgiveness? The master — God — generously gives his mercy and love to his servants which is of great value; how do we, his servants, use that gift? If we share it, we all benefit enormously, but if we bury it and ignore it, in the end we are the ones who suffer — like the servant who buried his master's talent.
