

31st Sunday in Ordinary Time – 4/5 November 2023 Thought for the Week

November is, and traditionally has been, the month where the Church calls upon us to remember those who have died, and to do so through our prayers. As the year — both calendar and liturgical - winds down, it seems appropriate to ask for God's love and mercy upon those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith.

Last week we began the month of November with two Holy Days that helped us focus our attention on the dead; the solemnity of All Saints, and the commemoration of all the faithful departed (All Souls). The first recognises and asks for the prayers of all who now wear, in the words of St Paul 'the crown of righteousness'. The second centres our prayer on those who have completed the earthly journey, yet are presently undergoing 'the final purification of the elect' (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1031).

The Church has always offered prayers for those who have died, above all the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that they may be purified and attain the beatific vision of God.

After somebody dies, we rightly support those who are left behind and grieve. While we should support and show our care for them, we should also extend our prayers for those who have died, and are probably still in need of our prayers.

In the month of November, we have a Book of Remembrance, where you can add names of those who have gone before usthese names will be remembered during the Masses of November.

We also have a special Bereavement Celebration where we remember those who have died and call forth their name. This will take place on Sunday 5 November at 15:00.
