

6th Sunday in Ordinary Time - 11 February 2024 Thought for the Week

It is sometimes quite surprising how appropriate a piece of scripture can be - this weekend's second reading is just such an example. Saint Paul tells the Corinthians that whatever they do, they are to do it for the glory of God. The Apostle goes on to say that he tries to be always helpful to everyone and is anxious for the benefit of everyone. He urges his readers and listeners to take him for their model as he takes Christ.

Supporting each other, seeking another's advantage, taking Christ as our model and being Christ to another goes to the heart of the Christian message and is as relevant to our own community as it was to the Colossians. There are so many ways in which we already help and seek to engage with each other, at different stages of our lives. At some points we need support ourselves and at others we can offer it, be it through our parish or wider community, to our youth, to our elders, to strangers. We assist through our prayer, liturgy, sacraments and programmes, our welcome, hospitality, outreach, and inclusion. Yet we often do not always know the breadth and depth of what happens across a parish or see where we can help or where, if we need it, we can seek help.

As Lent begins, from next weekend, 17/18 February, a campaign will start in our parish to help us explore and become aware of the richness and diversity of what goes on in the parish. It will ask each of us the question how we can use our Time, and what are our Talents and Treasures which we can use and offer to the advantage of everyone else, what are our gifts and skills which we can share, what are the gaps that we can fill, how can we work together to all become closer to Christ - Paul's model and our model. Stay tuned, there's more to come - in church, on-line and in the newsletter. . .
