Time, Talents and Treasures

In the Gospel for the first Sunday in Lent we read that Jesus journeyed into the desert, after which he proclaimed the Good News: 'the time has come' he announced, 'the Kingdom of God is close at hand'. Let us this Lent start our journey by sharing that Good News with each other.

Lent touches something in all of us. The image of Jesus fasting and praying in the desert moves us. However, it also forces us to look at our lives and it challenges us to improve ourselves. There is such a thing as moments of grace, Lent is a great window of opportunity; if we wish to change, we must substitute new habits for old ones. Lent is the Church's holy spring, it is a time of prayer and effort, but it can be a time of great joy; as we progress towards Easter the sun gets brighter and warmer.

This weekend we continue our journey to become Closer to Christ by becoming more connected and involved through our service to others. A 'Time, Talents and Treasures' leaflet will be distributed to all parishioners at Masses this weekend (it is also available on the website). We are asked to read, reflect upon, complete and return the leaflet; it's a step to exploring how we each can benefit from the other's service.

As we prepare our Parish for the future, let us pray for success in our mission and challenge ourselves to see what Time, Talents and Treasures we can share with one another as we build our parish with living stones for the future.
