

Second Sunday in Lent - 25 February 2024

Thought for the Week

You will be familiar with a particular theme in the Gospel of Mark. Often, after someone has experienced a healing, or as in today's Gospel, after the Transfiguration, Jesus tells them, 'see that you tell no one about what you have seen and heard'. This can seem very strange. If Jesus's mission was to come into the world to preach the Kingdom of God, and to draw all people to himself, certainly being known as a healer or miracle worker, and one who is proclaimed by God as 'my beloved son', would surely help the mission of Christ? But Jesus is concerned with people receiving the full revelation of who he is, not just as a healer, miracle, worker, or even the beloved Son of God, but also as the fully human person of the divine who will undergo suffering and death.

Coming to know the full person of Jesus takes time. Sometimes it means that we need to change our type of prayer or how we approach our prayer time. Reading more of Jesus in the Gospels or using our gifts and talents for the good of the community can enable us to encounter an aspect of Christ that we see present in other people with whom we would not otherwise come into contact.

Let us not be content with just having one view of who Christ is do something radical this Lent so that you might encounter the full person of Jesus Christ.
