Thought for the Week

In St John's Gospel, the first words out of mouth of Jesus is an invitation that the entire Gospel tries to answer: 'What are you looking for'? Throughout John's Gospel, Jesus tells us we're looking for many things; living water that quenches our deepest thirst, a truth that sets us free, a rebirth to something above, a light that shines eternally. All these images seem a little abstract. Near the end of the Gospel, we have that poignant, post resurrection meeting between Jesus and Mary Magdala. It takes place in a garden, a place where love takes place.

Mary, carrying spices to embalm Jesus's body, goes searching for him on Easter morning. She meets him but doesn't recognise him. Supposing him to be the gardener, she asked where she might find the body of the dead Jesus. Jesus replies by repeating the question that he answered at the beginning of the Gospel of John. 'Who are you looking for'? Before she can answer it, he gives the deepest answer. To that question he pronounces her name in love; 'Mary'. This was what she was looking for - many people also are looking for that personal relationship with Jesus who calls us by name and invites us to follow him.

I invite you to volunteer to join our visiting group in the parish so that we can reach out and bring this message into the lives of those who are perhaps unknowingly waiting to be called by name.
